Greening Central Virginia

Located in Caroline County on 14 acres near I-95 and U.S. Route 1 is the new Union Bankshares Corporation's Operations Center, the first comprehensive environmentally-friendly development in Central Virginia. The 70,000 square foot Corporate Center is LEED-Silver certified. The building has been designed to reduce water and energy needs and to capture, filter and reduce stormwater run-off with a 23,000 square foot vegetated green roof, innovative bioretention parking lot, and native plantings. Union Bank is partnering with the Alliance for the Chesapeake Bay and several natural resource agencies, including the Hanover-Caroline Soil

& Water Conservation District, Virginia Cooperative Extension Caroline County, Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries, and the Department of Forestry, to showcase the Operations Center as a demonstration site of environmentally sensitive development.

This workshop will use the Center as a model to provide Corporate entities a better view of the environmental and economic benefits of "going green".

Bayscaping

BayScaping is the use of environmentally sound landscaping practices and a variety of beneficial native plants that, because they are adapted to our local climate and soil, require minimal maintenance (including trimming, watering, fertilizing or pesticide application). These plants reduce the amount of pollutants carried by rainwater into local waterways because they use less fertilizers and pesticides.
